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This week we have enjoyed learning about woodland animals. We have discussed the different animals found in woodlands and the places they live. The children were really good at naming these animals and they had a go at drawing and painting these.

In PE we used the parachute to make different woodland animals 'fly' (soft toys only!), we also thought about the different ways these animals move. We explored colour mixing to create different shades of green, like the leaves, we've used magnifying glasses and binoculars to look closely at plants and flowers. For Maths Champions we have looked at the different ways we can make numbers e.g., for the number 3 we had 2 girls and 1 boy and realised the total is still 3...For My Happy Mind we have taken time to listen, e.g., being able to listen and identify sounds outside - birds, cars, wind ...

In addition, we have explored how we can make shadows, enjoyed using our new white board pens, spent time developing our scissor control, made 'mud pies' in the mud kitchen, and helped clear out the construction area.
